


ADAM UP GAMES: Rolling for Dollars

Skill: Multiplying and Dividing by 10

Players: 2

Equipment: A dice, game board, pencil

Mission: You are contestants on Numberth's favourite game show - Rolling for Dollars! Can you win the most money?

How to Play:

1. To begin, each player rolls the dice to find their starting amount

Example: If a player rolls a '4', they will place a '4' in the '1s' column

2. Players then take it in turns to roll the dice

3. If they roll a 1, 2 or 3, they must divide their amount by 10. If they roll a 4, 5 or 6, they multiply their amount by 10.

4. Players have a maximum of 5 rolls, but they can choose to stop and bank their money at any point.

5. After the 5 rolls (or if players decide to stop), the round is over and players record their score in the table on the game board

6. This is repeated for rounds 2 and 3.

7. Once round 3 is complete, the players add their scores from the 3 rounds to discover the winner.
