





# ADAM UP GAMES: Rolling for Dollars

# ADAM UP GAMES: Rolling for Dollars

**Skill:** Place Value (hundreds, tens, units)

**Players:** 2

**Equipment:** 1 dice, game board, pencil, counters (optional - if used, a maximum of 20 per game is needed)

**Mission:** You are contestants on Numberth's favourite game show - Rolling for Dollars! Can you end the game with the most money and end up winning?

## How to Play:

1. Players take it in turns to roll the dice and follow the action depending from the game sheet

*Example:* If a player rolls a 3, they must write a '1' or place a counter in the '100s' column

*Note.* If a 4, 5 or 6 is rolled and there is nothing in this column then do nothing.

2. Players can each have a maximum of 10 rolls. However, they can stop at any time and bank their score.

3. Once both players have had their 10 rolls or have decided to stop, the game is over and the player with the highest score wins.
